The thought of a "European passport" had been present in our family for a long time, some said maybe from the Polish side, some said maybe from the Czech side, some even gathered information and documents but no one actually did anything or made any real move.

Towards the end of 2014 I decided that it was time to check out the matter seriously.

I knew that neither I nor my brother had the time, patience, or knowledge to do anything about it so I went in search of someone who could help me out and take care of it for me.

Searching the web for someone appropriate, I found Conbiz and contacted them (Shauli and Amos). I am a very suspicious person (certainly of someone I had found on the internet) but after several phone calls and e-mails I decided to take the chance and go for it.

Several things that encouraged and convinced me:

1. The price seemed fair.
2. The fact that at first I was only required to pay a small part of the fee to check out our eligibility and whether the full process is worthwhile.
3. A formal contract, in which the changes I requested were willingly incorporated.

From this point on my role was simple. I transferred the necessary documents as instructed by Amos and Shauli, some of which were already in my possession and some I had to obtain from the various government offices (such as a Certificate of Marriage, etc.).

From the moment we transferred all the documents it took less than six months to receive the citizenship documents that made it possible to receive a passport.

To this day I have met neither Amos nor Shauli, to my regret, but the service I received was reliable, professional, and quick, and for that I thank them and warmly recommend them.
